- Sky Dive at 10,000 feet
- Min. Age 16
(With Parental or Guardian consent)
- 30 minute training session
- 20 minute flight
- Reach over 120MPH
- 50 seconds of free falling
- 5-7 minute canopy flight

WHAT IS A TANDEM SKYDIVE?

A Tandem Skydive means that you are securely attached to an experienced and qualified British Parachute Association (BPA) approved Tandem Skydive Instructor.

This means you can experience everything this has to offer without any previous experience.

There is no upper age restriction to skydiving, however if you have any pre-existing medical conditions, your Medical Declaration form must be signed and stamped by your GP.

HOW LONG DOES THE SKYDIVE TAKE?

Once you have boarded the Aircraft and left the Ground it will take about 20 minutes to reach 13,000ft.

You will be securely attached to your Instructor before take-off and once the Aircraft reaches 13,000ft your turn will come to exit.

You will immediately feel the rush of 'free fall' reaching speeds of up to 120mph or more!

You will experience 'free fall' for around 50 seconds and when you reach 5,000ft your Instructor will deploy the Parachute.

You will experience the different feelings between the incredible exhilaration of 'free fall' to the calm, serene peaceful movement of the parachute descending.

You will then enjoy a 5-7 minute Canopy flight taking in the breath-taking views. Your Instructor may even let you have a go at steering the canopy!

WHAT DO I WEAR?

Comfortable clothing such as a tracksuit and trainers is best. Slip on shoes, shoes with hooks or high hills are not to be worn.

You will be issued a jump suit, Goggles and a Hat to wear for your Skydive. It is your responsibility to bring gloves.

Don't worry if you wear Spectacles as the Goggles are especially designed to fit over them.

On top of the jumpsuit you will wear a Harness which attaches you to your Instructor.

WHO ARE THE INSTRUCTORS?

Don't worry...you are in very safe hands! All of our Instructors are approved and registered members of the British Parachuting Association (BPA) and they are very experienced 'free-fall' Parachutist who hold up to date BPA Tandem Instructor Ratings. They have all been trained to the highest standard and have several years of experience.

On top of the jumpsuit you will wear a Harness which attaches you to your Instructor.

ARE THERE ANY MEDICAL RESTRICTIONS?

Plenty of people with a range of medical condition and/or a Disability take part in Tandem Skydives every year.

There is not that much that will stop you, however if you have a known medical condition or disability you will have to get your GP to sign the BPA Medical Declarations form. Forms can be obtained from us before paying a deposit.

Maximum weight limit for doing a tandem skydive is 15 stone 7lbs and maximum height is 6 foot 3 inches.
